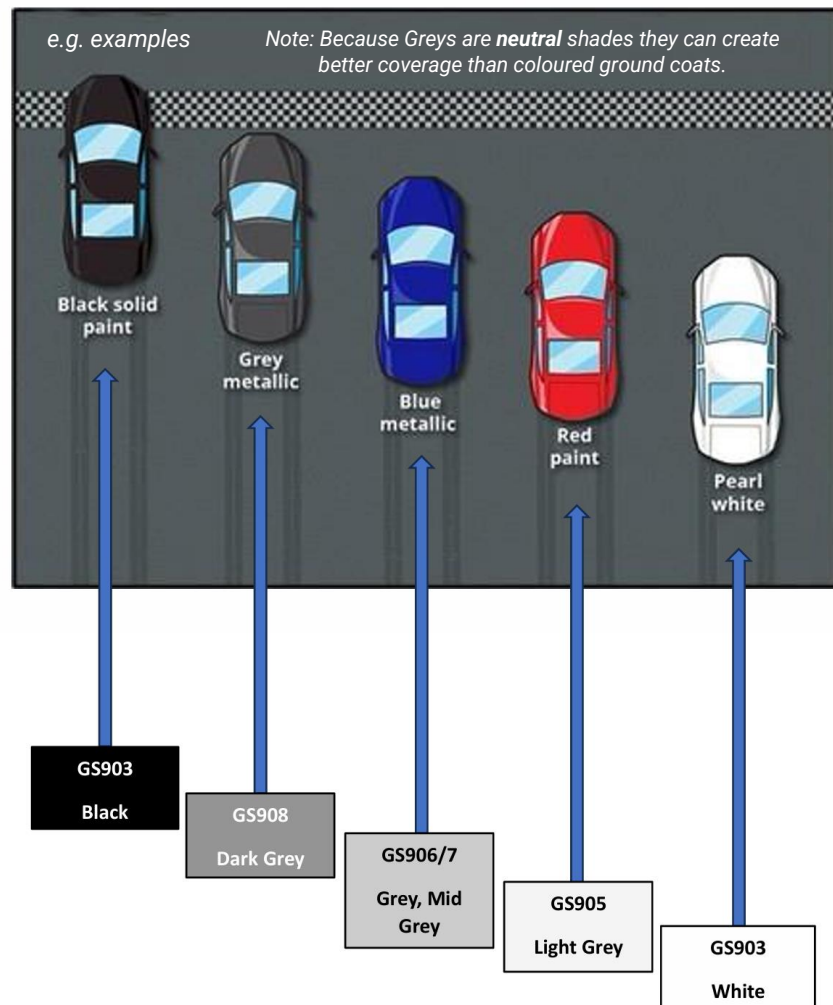


## DBNZ Tech Tip of The Week

### Primer/Ground Coat Shade Recommendations for Under Different Colours

Because modern automotive colours have more transparent qualities than ever before, to help achieve the illusion of coverage over repair panels it is important to use a **GREY SHADE Primer/Groundcoat** that is most suited to the colour of the car itself.
